# **Receiving Blessing**

#### Jacob deceives

- <sup>18</sup> He went to his father and said, "My father." "Yes, my son," he answered. "Who is it?"
- <sup>19</sup> Jacob said to his father, "I am Esau your firstborn. I have done as you told me. Please sit up and eat some of my game, so that you may give me your blessing."
- <sup>20</sup> Isaac asked his son, "How did you find it so quickly, my son?" "The LORD your God gave me success," he replied.
- <sup>21</sup> Then Isaac said to Jacob, "Come near so I can touch you, my son, to know whether you really are my son Esau or not."
- <sup>22</sup> Jacob went close to his father Isaac, who touched him and said, "The voice is the voice of Jacob, but the hands are the hands of Esau."
- <sup>23</sup> He did not recognize him, for his hands were hairy like those of his brother Esau; so he proceeded to bless him.

#### Isaac blesses

- <sup>24</sup> "Are you really my son Esau?" he asked. "I am," he replied.
- <sup>25</sup> Then he said, "My son, bring me some of your game to eat, so that I may give you my blessing." Jacob brought it to him and he ate; and he brought some wine and he drank.
- <sup>26</sup> Then his father Isaac said to him, "Come here, my son, and kiss me."
- <sup>27</sup> So he went to him and kissed him. When Isaac caught the smell of his clothes, he blessed him and said, "Ah, the smell of my son is like the smell of a field that the LORD has blessed.

#### Esau returns

- 30 After Isaac finished blessing him, and Jacob had scarcely left his father's presence, his brother Esau came in from hunting.
- <sup>32</sup> His father Isaac asked him, "Who are you?" "I am your son," he answered, "your firstborn, Esau."
- 33 Isaac trembled violently and said, "Who was it, then, that hunted game and brought it to me? I ate it just before you came and I blessed him—and indeed he will be blessed!"
- <sup>34</sup> When Esau heard his father's words, he burst out with a loud and bitter cry and said to his father, "Bless me-me too, my father!"
- <sup>35</sup> But he said, "Your brother came deceitfully and took your blessing."
